A systemic approach to using and reusing resources most efficiently and sustainably throughout their lifecycles. It seeks to minimize materials used and all associated environmental impacts."



Municipal Solid Waste Generation in 2013 254 Million Tons (before recycling)





Food Recovery

More food reaches landfills and incinerators than any other single material in municipal solid waste (MSW).

In 2013 alone, more than 37 million tons of food waste was generated, with only five percent diverted from landfills and incinerators for composting.

Results of Grant

326.4 tons of Food and Packaging Waste were diverted from the landfill as a result of this project as of October 2015.

These entities will continue to divert their organics and help spread the word.
