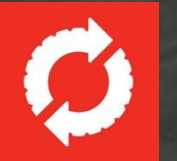

We started with the idea that community composting is for the soil.

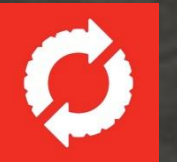


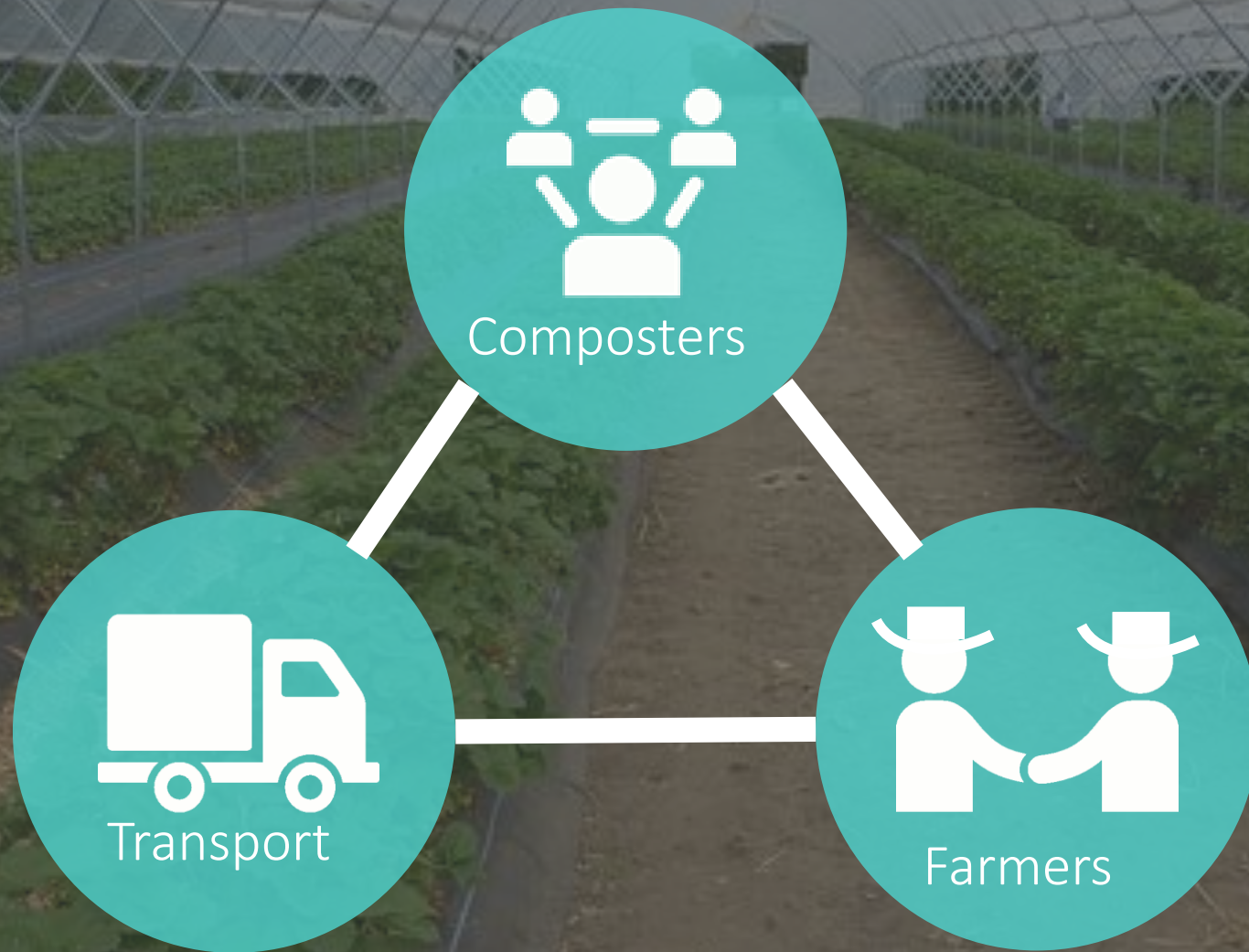

- Public and private processing infrastructure

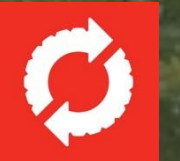
