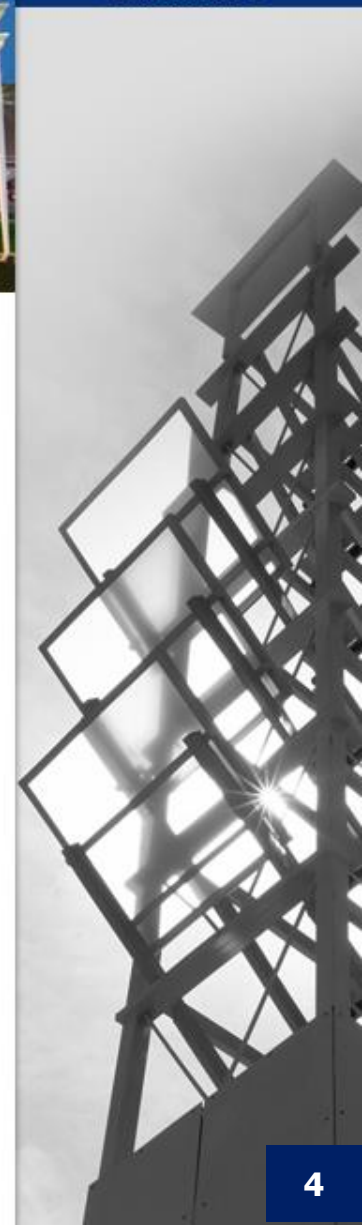

Solar Arrays

GWCC's Marshalling Yard 4 is now covered with 1,900 solar PV panels that will contribute to Mercedes-Benz Stadium's 1.6 million kWh project on the campus that will be enough to power 160 homes



Energy Saving Performance Contract

Oct. 2015 to Sept. 2016

- \$983,849 of energy costs saved
- \$173,167 Georgia Power rebates
- 5,583,710 kWh of electricity saved
- 16,312,384 gallons of water saved
- 536,666 pounds (268 tons) of construction waste recycled
