- Around 800 members
  - -Majority are company/organization memberships
  - Represent compost manufacturers, suppliers, consultants, policy makers, composting supporters




#### Advocacy Issues

#### States with Organics Legislation





- Growing a Greener World with Joe Lampl












#### International Compost Awareness Week
